Every 3rd week of October we invite BNI Chapters to engage with a local school to showcase how business owners can network and collaborate to help each other become more successful.

Ideally the Weekly Meeting takes place in a school, followed by the career orientation sessions offered by selected BNI members.

If the chosen school is unable to accommodate a full Chapter Meeting, there are two other options for participating:

- 1. The career orientation takes place at a mutually convenient time in the school.
- 2. The career orientation can take place at any other local young people's club.
